SSUFC Criminal Record & Vulnerable Sector Check (2026)

The intent of the letter is to advise you that _____
is a Volunteer Coach or Team Manager of SSUFC which requires a Criminal Record Check
and a Vulnerable Sector Check.

In their role, this person will require direct contact with male and/or females under the age of
19 and will be acting in a position of supervision, authority and care.

Members of the coaching staff are expected to spend significant time with players, both on
and off the soccer fields and may be in both private and public settings. During these
encounters, coaching staff are expected to provide mentoring, emotional support, and physical
support for assessing and treating injuries.

This check is a requirement of the Saugeen Shores United Football Club through its
affiliation with Ontario Soccer for all individuals holding the title of coach, assistant coach,
trainer, assistant trainer and manager as a volunteer. This person is functioning in a volunteer
position and will not receive remuneration for their services.
