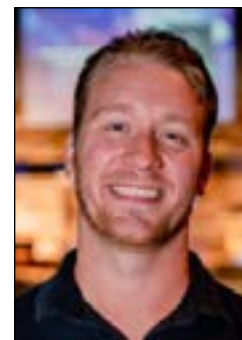
Welcome

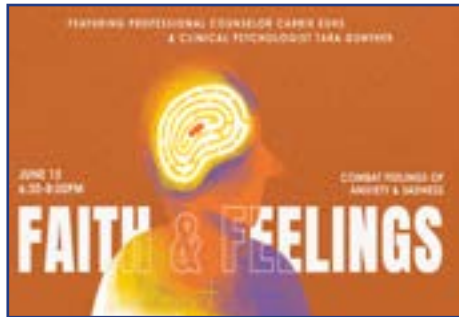

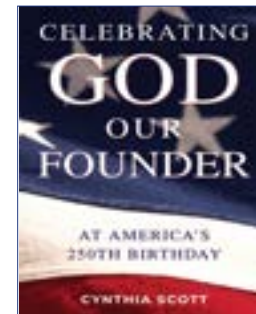
