John the Baptist Prepares the Way

1 The beginning of the gospel about Jesus Christ, the Son of God.^a

2 It is written in Isaiah the prophet:

"I will send my messenger ahead of you,
who will prepare your way"^b—

3 "a voice of one calling in the desert,
Prepare the way for the Lord,
make straight paths for him."

4 And so John came, baptizing in the desert region and preaching of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. 5 The whole crowd went out to him. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River. 6 John wore clothing made of camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. 7 And this was his message: "After me will come one more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry, and who will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire."

The Calling of the First Disciples

14 After John was put in prison, Jesus went into Galilee, proclaiming the good news of God. 15 "The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news!"

16 As Jesus walked beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the sea, for they were fishermen. 17 Jesus said to them, "Come, follow me, and I will make you become fishers of men." 18 They left their nets and followed him.

Jesus Drives Out an Evil Spirit

21 They went to Capernaum, and when the sabbath came, Jesus went into the synagogue and began to teach. The people were amazed at his teaching, because he taught them as one who

9 At that time Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. 10 As Jesus was coming up out of the water, he saw heaven being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. 11 And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased."

12 At once the Spirit sent him out into the desert, 13 and he was in the desert forty days, being tempted by Satan. He

gogue who was possessed by an evil spirit cried out, 24 "What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!" 25 "Be quiet," said Jesus sternly. "Come out of him!" 26 The evil spirit came out of him with a shriek.

27 The people were all so amazed that they asked each other, "What is this? New teaching—and with authority! He

even gives orders to evil spirits that they obey him." 28 News about him spread quickly over the whole Galilee.

Jesus Heals Many

29 As soon as they left the synagogue, they went with James and John to the home of Simon and Andrew. 30 Simon's mother-in-law was in bed with fever, and they told Jesus about her. 31 He went to her, took her hand and helped her up. The fever left her and she went to wait on them.

32 That evening after sunset Jesus brought to Jesus all the sick and demon-possessed. 33 The whole crowd gathered at the door, 34 and Jesus healed many who had various ailments. 35 Some drew on Jesus, trying to touch him, because they were full of demons. 36 Jesus said, "Do not touch me, for I am full of demons."

Jesus Preaches in the Synagogue

37 Very early in the morning Jesus got up and went off to a solitary place. 38 Simon and the others went to look for him. 39 When they found him, they said, "Everyone is looking for you, and we are here." 40 Jesus replied, "Let us go where else—to the nearby villages. I can preach there also. That will save some." 41 So he traveled out Galilee, preaching in the synagogues and driving out demons.

A Man With Leprosy

40 A man with leprosy came and

reached out with his hand and touched him. "I am willing," he said, "but you must first say 'clean!'" 42 Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cured.

43 Jesus sent him away at once with a warning: 44 "See that you do not tell this to anyone. But go, show yourself to the priest and offer the sacrifices that Moses commanded for those who are cleansed, as a testimony to all."

45 Instead he went out and began to spread the news. A

Sunday, March 22: Devo at M4C. We will be providing the meal for the college group. Come ready to cook and to serve!

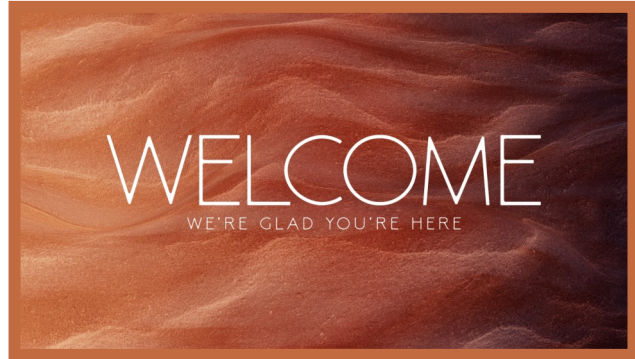
