What is communion?

Days before Jesus was crucified on the cross He gathered His followers (disciples) together and shared the first communion with them. Take a look at what Jesus says to His disciples during this gathering.

'The time came for them to eat the Passover meal. Jesus and the apostles were together at the table. Jesus said to them, "I wanted very much to eat this Passover meal with you before I die. I will never eat another Passover meal until it is given its full meaning in God's kingdom." Then Jesus took a cup of wine. He gave thanks to God for it and said, "Take this cup and give it to everyone here. I will never drink wine again until God's kingdom comes." Then he took some bread and thanked God for it. He broke off some pieces, gave them to the apostles and said, "This bread is my body that I am giving for you. Eat this to remember me." In the same way, after supper, Jesus took the cup of wine and said, "This wine represents the new agreement from God to his people. It will begin when my blood is poured out for you.' '

Jesus took the cup of wine - The wine represents Jesus' blood. We receive forgiveness of sins because of Jesus' blood.

Ephesians 1:7 ESV In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace,

Jesus then took the bread - Jesus broke it into pieces and passed it to the disciples. The bread represents the body of Jesus that was broken for us.

John 6:51 ESV I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats this bread, he will live forever. And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh.

Because Jesus sacrificed His body and His blood we are completely forgiven when we put our faith in Him and confess it with our mouth. Jesus did all of this out of love so that we can have a relationship with Him. When we eat the bread and drink the juice we are remembering that we didn't have to do anything to earn God's love, because Jesus already did everything when He died on the cross.
