

# April 5 - Resurrection Sunday: The Risen King

Primary Text: Gospel of Luke 24:1–12

Supporting Texts: First Epistle to the Corinthians 15:3–8, 20–22; Epistle to the Romans 4:25

Main Idea: The One who set His face toward Jerusalem rose in triumph from the grave.

## Family Opening Activity

Empty Tomb Illustration

Create a small “tomb” from a box and roll the “stone” away.

Discuss why the empty tomb matters.

## Preschool Activity

“He Is Alive!” Celebration

Shout: “Christ is risen!”

Response: “He is risen indeed!”

## Elementary Activity

Eyewitness Testimony Game

Take turns describing something seen earlier.

Connect to 1 Corinthians 15 eyewitnesses.

## Teen Activity

Defense of the Resurrection

Discuss why the resurrection validates the cross.

What would Christianity be without it?

## Adult Reflection

Read Romans 4:25.

Reflect on justification secured.

## End-of-Day Wrap-Up

Family Celebration Prayer

Declare together:

“Christ is risen!”

Pray that your family lives boldly, joyfully, and holy as resurrection people.
