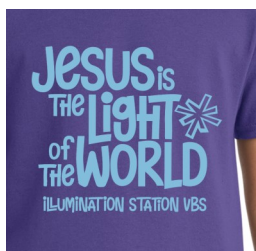
Shining a Light on Who Jesus Really Is

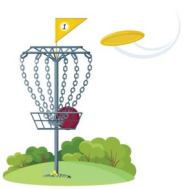
