Pray for the team’s safety and the power to uplift people they touch who are recovering from flooding and other hardships.

The Board of Trustees reviewed the status of our HVAC at their recent meeting.

It was determined that while some aspects of addressing the status of our HVAC are moving forward, other aspects have reached an impasse. After discussion, it was decided that a dedicated management approach is needed to move forward. To ensure our project moves ahead, a specialized project management team (PMT) has been tasked with overseeing our HVAC project. Trustee Bob Hockett is forming the team. Once the team has created their purpose statement, our PMT will schedule individuals and companies to make presentations and conduct a time for question-and-answers.
