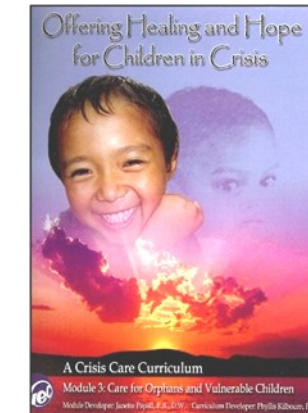
**MYANMAR TRAINING**

In my last newsletter, I asked you to pray for the training that would take place in Myanmar via Zoom! I asked you to pray for several things, and **God answered every one of those prayers.**

Three to four mornings a week for five weeks, I got up at 4:45 am and was on my computer by 5:45. I was greeted by 60 smiling, ready-to-learn children's workers. The internet connection was great, the English-to-Burmese translator was brilliant, and each day's message was well received across the ocean by those hungry for trauma skills. 60 workers showed up for every class! That is amazing! **Your prayers make a difference!**

*There is Hope for Me* in Burmese is complete! What a miracle!!

This month, over 20 workers who completed our Trauma Training will head to the city of Mandalay to provide a **There is Hope for Me** camp to children affected by the earthquake one year ago. **Please pray for this camp.**

## Westminster Shorter Catechism

Question 23: How is Christ our redeemer?

**Answer: As our redeemer, Christ is a prophet, priest, and king in both His humiliation and His exaltation.**

Question 24: How is Christ a prophet?

**Answer: As a prophet, Christ reveals the will of God to us for our salvation by His word and Spirit.**

Question 25: How is Christ a priest?

**Answer: As a priest, Christ offered Himself up once as a sacrifice for us to satisfy divine justice and to reconcile us to God, and He continually intercedes for us.**

Question 26: How is Christ a king?

**Answer: As a king, Christ brings us under His power, rules and defends us, and restrains and conquers all His and all our enemies.**
