

Quinceañera



Tradition:

One of the customs that Latin American communities have brought to this country is the celebration of the Quinceañera, which consists of the presentation of the young woman to the community as a dual religious and social act.

Religious:

It consists of an act of giving thanks to God for the gift of life with a sense of Eucharistic simplicity, where the quinceañera renews her baptismal commitment and prepares to work responsibly for the good of the community.

Social:

It consists of a reception and fellowship where the young woman is presented to society so that she may be recognized by all as a person capable of offering her Christian values.

Eucharistic Celebration:

It is recommended that the quinceañera receive the sacrament of reconciliation (confession) before the Saturday of the celebration.

REGISTRATION FOR CATECHISM AND QUINCEAÑERA MASS
