## *John the Baptist Prepares the Way*

1 The beginning of the gospel about Jesus Christ, the Son of God.<sup>a</sup>

2 It is written in Isaiah the prophet:

"I will send my messenger ahead of you,

who will prepare your way"<sup>b</sup>—

3 "a voice of one calling in the desert,

'Prepare the way for the Lord,  
make straight paths for him.'"<sup>c</sup>

4 And so John came, preaching in the

desert region and preaching a message of

repentance for the forgiveness of

sins.<sup>5</sup> The whole crowd of people went

out to him. Confessing their sins, they

were baptized by him in the Jordan

river. 6 John wore clothing made of camel's

hair, with a leather belt around his

waist, and he ate locusts and wild

figs. 7 And this was his message: "After

me will come one more powerful than I,  
the thongs of whose sandals I am not

worthy to untie, and he will baptize you

with the Holy Spirit."<sup>8</sup>

9 At that time Jesus came from Nazareth

in Galilee and was baptized by John in the

Jordan. 10 As Jesus was coming up out of

the water, he saw heaven being torn open

and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. 11 And a voice

came from heaven, saying, "You are my Son,  
whom I love; with you I am well pleased."<sup>12</sup>

14 After John was put in prison, Jesus

went into Galilee, proclaiming the good

news of God. 15 "The time has come,"

he said. "The kingdom of God is near. Repent

and believe the good news!"<sup>16</sup>

17 He called to them, "Follow me, and I will

send you out to fish for people."<sup>18</sup>

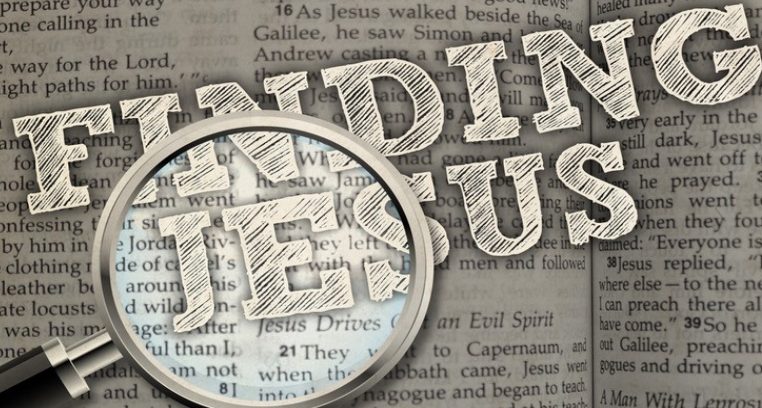
