Luke 22:39-46— *Sincere prayer demonstrates an open and trusting relationship with God that brings His strength for the journey.*

Sunday, January 11, 2026— “Instructive Irony”

Luke 22:47-53— *With an openness to God’s grace and power, we can possess a real and trusting faith in Jesus Christ.*

Sunday, January 18, 2026— “Jesus to Trial”

Luke 22:54-71— *Luke—How will you respond to the Son of Man, who is now seated at the right hand of the Father?*

Sunday, February 1, 2026— “Missing Jesus”

Luke 23:1-12— *Various forms of selfishness cause us to “miss” Jesus and true faith in Him.*

Sunday, February 8, 2026— “Theology in Surprises”

Luke 23:13-25— *As sinister and unfair as it was, Jesus’ trial points to the essential and wonderful theological truth that the innocent died for the guilty.*

Sunday, February 15, 2026— “His Own Witness”

Luke 23:26-43— *As our prophet, priest and king, Jesus is the compassionate Savior who rescues sinners from God’s coming wrath into His kingdom.*
