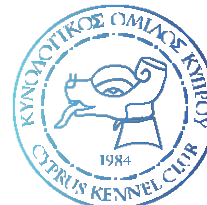

Section 4: Responsible Declaration & Signature

By signing, you accept and declare responsibly that:

- All information is true.
- You approve and undertake the obligation to respect and comply with the Articles of Association and the Internal Regulations of the C.O.C. (Cyprus Kennel Club).
- Your personal information will be recorded and used by the K.O.K. in accordance with the GDPR.

The registration fee is €45 (including VAT) for members and €55 (including VAT) for NON members, plus an additional €25 (including VAT) for members and €35 (including VAT) for non-members, for each dog/puppy.

RESPONSIBLE DECLARATION

By submitting this declaration, you understand and confirm that:

- To the best of your knowledge, the information you have provided in this declaration is true, correct, and complete.
- You agree to the latest terms and conditions and privacy policy.
- **Personal Data Protection:** The K.O.K. (Cyprus Kennel Club) maintains records that include personal data of individuals registered in its registry and/or in the dog registry, of which you are the owner(s), for the purpose of complying with the provisions of the laws of the Republic of Cyprus as applied by the K.O.K.
- The data kept in these records are bound by confidentiality and are protected as provided by the General Data Protection Regulation – European Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR), which came into force on 25 May 2018. The K.O.K. may use the information provided through this Responsible Declaration to verify the accuracy of the information, to prevent or detect offences, and to protect the integrity of its records and revenues.
- You may be prosecuted and/or subject to disciplinary action and/or criminal prosecution under the law if you intentionally provide false or misleading information.
- The K.O.K. reserves the right not to proceed with any service you request if it determines, or in the opinion of its staff or the Board of Directors, that your application contains false information or that the submitted data are suspected to be altered, false, or incorrect. In such cases, fees are non-refundable, and by your signature you accept this condition as well as the relevant regulations and terms governing the processing of requested services.
- In the event that falsification or submission of applications containing false information or not complying with the K.O.K. regulations is detected, the K.O.K. reserves the right to impose sanctions even in your absence. By signing this declaration, you accept this condition as well as the internal regulations and Articles of Association of the K.O.K.
- This information helps verify the accuracy of the provided data and identify when members or registered dog owners fail to comply with the internal regulations, the Articles of Association, or decisions of the Board of Directors, which form part of the K.O.K. regulations. If it is found that a breeder does not declare a litter, or does not declare all puppies (whether partially or even one puppy is omitted), their kennel license and registered kennel name (AFFIX NAME) will be immediately revoked, and they will be removed as a member and/or have all member, breeder, exhibitor, or judge rights suspended, in accordance with a majority decision of the Board of Directors of the K.O.K., taken either in a meeting or via electronic means (e.g. Viber or other communication methods).
- In the event that a breeder does not declare correct information regarding the parents or the puppies of a litter, or does not declare all puppies (whether partially or even one puppy is omitted), by signing this application you unconditionally accept that the litter will not be registered. Additionally, your kennel license and registered kennel name (AFFIX NAME) will be immediately revoked, and you will be removed as a member and/or have your rights as a member, breeder, exhibitor, or judge suspended, in accordance with a majority decision of the Board of Directors of the Cyprus Kennel Club (K.O.K.).

INTERNAL REGULATIONS – CHAPTER II (ARTICLE 17 to ARTICLE 43) Regulations for Breeding and Registration of Dogs



**HIGHLIGHTING SOME OF THE ARTICLES AS BELOW,
HOWEVER, YOU ARE OBLIGED TO BE AWARE OF ALL ARTICLES.**

BREEDER

• Article 18

As a general rule, the breeder of a litter is considered to be the owner of the female dog at the time of mating.

• Article 20A

If it is found that a breeder does not declare a litter or fails to declare even one puppy from a declared litter, their kennel license and the right to hold a registered kennel name (AFFIX NAME) will be revoked. Additionally, a fine of €500 will be imposed. Re-registration of the kennel will not be possible before the lapse of 2 years, and will require payment of a fee of €500–€1000 instead of the current €100, depending on the case and at the discretion of the Board of Directors of the K.O.K.

• Article 21

Breeders are prohibited from registering puppies in any pedigree registry other than the K.O.K. Stud Book and are required to sign the litter declaration to ensure this. Otherwise, disciplinary or financial penalties will be imposed as determined by decision of the Board of Directors of the K.O.K.

REGISTRATION OF THE LITTER

• Article 22

A necessary condition for registering a purebred litter is the submission of a litter registration application and certification by persons authorized by the K.O.K. (inspectors) before the expiry of 75 days from the date of birth of the litter. The K.O.K. reserves the right to impose a fine or to reject the application if submitted after this period (based on postmark date).

AGE FOR MATING – MALES

• Article 25

Mating must be carried out by a stud dog older than nine months at the time of mating, provided that the requirements of Article 25B are met.

AGE FOR MATING – FEMALES

• Article 25A

I. Breeds weighing over 30 kg may mate at the age of 18 months. The K.O.K. reserves the right, if deemed necessary, to request certification from a veterinarian of its choosing confirming that the female is in good health and able to carry and deliver puppies without risk to her life or causing harm to her anatomy and welfare.

II. Breeds weighing between 10–30 kg must mate at the age of 16 months.

III. All breeds weighing under 10 kg must mate at a minimum age of 14 months.

IV. All breeds must comply with Article 25B regardless of weight.

V. The maximum mating age is determined according to the breed and is set at $\frac{3}{4}$ or 75% of the life expectancy, as defined in an approved reference table. The K.O.K. reserves the right to request veterinary certification confirming the female's fitness, as above.

VI. Maintenance of records.

RECORD KEEPING

• Article 37

I. Any person who breeds, keeps, transfers ownership or possession, or trades in purebred dogs registered in the K.O.K. Stud Book is required to maintain adequate records relating to the above activities. and accurate records which may be obtained from the K.O.K.

INTERNAL REGULATIONS

• Article 38

I. Every breeder is obliged to keep the whelping unit with the mother and puppies for at least 8 weeks, and in any case until the litter is inspected by a K.O.K. inspector, regardless of whether nursing is still ongoing, in accordance with the litter declaration and at the address stated in the litter form. In the event of an inspection and if it is found that the entire whelping unit is not at the declared address without prior notification to the K.O.K., the Internal Regulations and Disciplinary Rules, Chapter IV, shall apply.

• Article 38

Any person who is required to keep records and fails to do so, or is unable to present them upon request for inspection by an authorized representative of the K.O.K., may have all privileges granted by the K.O.K. revoked by decision of the Board of Directors or the Disciplinary Committee.

BREEDING INSPECTIONS

• Article 39

Authorized representatives of the K.O.K. (inspectors), appointed by the registrar, shall inspect breeding and whelping facilities of purebred dogs without prior notice. Refusal of inspection following a complaint from an inspector is subject to the Disciplinary Provisions of the K.O.K. Statutes and the Internal Regulations, Chapter IV, and may result in fines or penalties as provided by the statutes and Chapter IV in cases of evasion.

• Article 40

Any person who keeps or breeds purebred dogs and refuses inspection by authorized representatives of the K.O.K. may have all privileges granted by the K.O.K. revoked by decision of the Board of Directors or the Disciplinary Committee, subject to the Disciplinary Provisions of the K.O.K. Statutes and Internal Regulations, Chapter IV, and may be fined or otherwise penalized, including cases of evasion.

• Article 41

A written report to the Board of Directors of the K.O.K. shall be submitted by the authorized representative of the K.O.K. regarding cases under Articles 38, 39, and 40.

• Article 43

For as long as the K.O.K. deems it necessary for any reason to conduct DNA testing on any dog registered in the Cyprus Stud Book, the K.O.K. shall cover the cost of the tests. If the information is proven false, the K.O.K. will impose disciplinary penalties and the responsible party will bear the cost of the examination. Results, whether positive or negative, will be announced at the General Assembly of the K.O.K. and to breed clubs. Pedigree certificates will be revoked and fees will not be refunded. The breeder will be called to submit a written explanation to the K.O.K. Board of Directors within 15 days; otherwise, the breeder may face penalties up to and including lifetime disqualification.
