Westminster Shorter Catechism Screen

Question 32: What benefits do those who are effectually called partake of in this life?
Answer: Those who are effectually called partake in this life of justification, adoption and sanctification, and the various benefits which either accompany or flow from them in this life.

Question 33: What is justification?
Answer: Justification is an act of God's free grace by which he pardons all our sins and accepts us as righteous in his sight, only because of the righteousness of Christ imputed to us, received by faith alone.

Question 34: What is adoption?
Answer: Adoption is an act of God's free grace by which we are received into the number of the sons of God and have a right to all the privileges of them.

Question 35: What is sanctification?
Answer: Sanctification is the work of God's free grace by which we are renewed in our whole person in the image of God and by which we are enabled more and more to die to sin and live to righteousness.

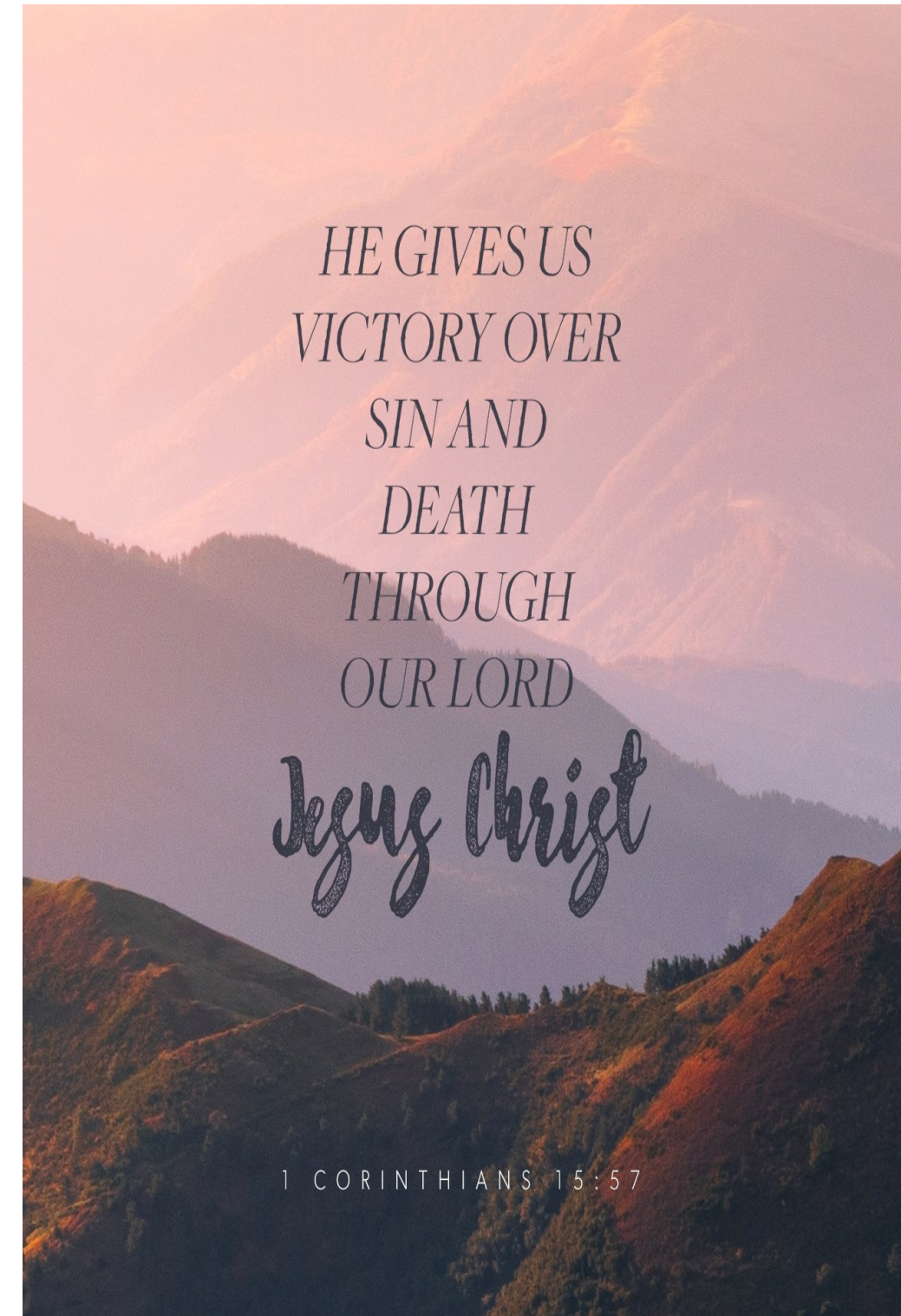
