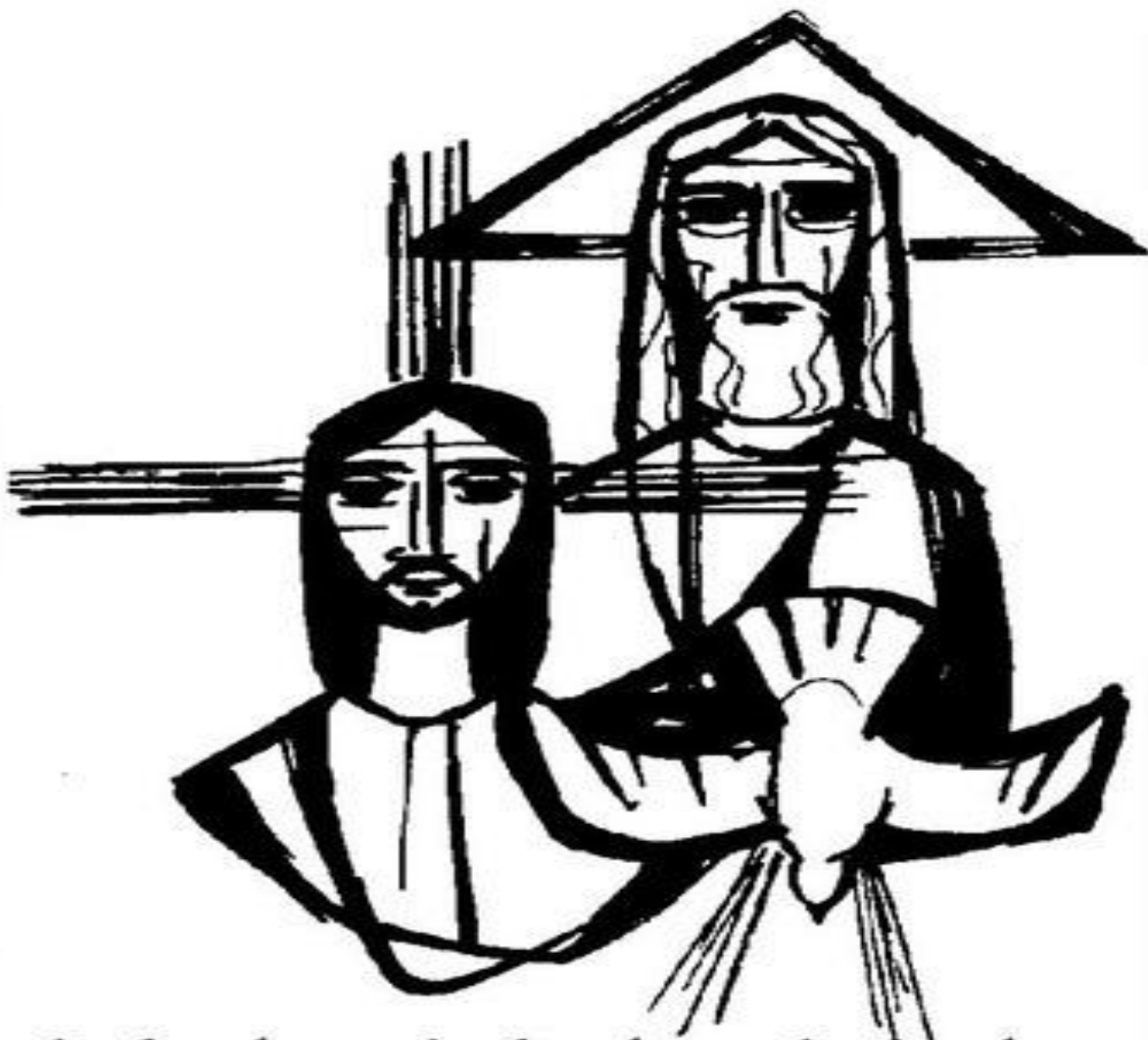

†Affirmation of Faith from the Belhar Confession
