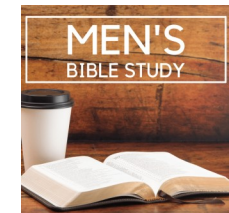

“I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world.” (John 16:33)

Consider the awesome truths of this passage today.

1. We will all suffer in some way. Jesus said “you will have tribulation” not “you might have tribulation.” While we may not look forward to tribulation, we should not be surprised by it (1 Peter 4:12).
2. Christ offers us peace in the midst of tribulation. Whatever affliction, anxiety, stress, trial or moment of suffering that may come our way....we are offered peace through Christ in the midst of those tribulations.
3. We come to understand the peace that Christ offers us through His word....the Bible. Jesus said, “I have said these things to you, that....”. We find peace in the midst of tribulation when we read, meditate on and study the Scriptures.
4. We can be strengthened in the midst of tribulation with the reminder that Christ has overcome the world. He has defeated sin and death. He prepares a place for us, free of all tribulation, in a new heaven and new earth.

Take time to consider today what tribulations you have faced or are facing. Are you at peace in the midst of them? Are you trusting in Christ? Are you reading and meditating on His word?

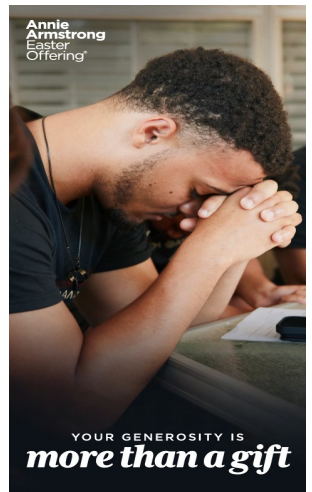
