

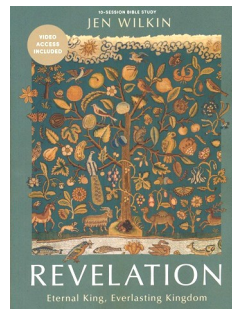

Title: The Kingdom is Identified

* Westminster Shorter Catechism

Question 17: Into what state did the fall bring mankind?
Answer: The fall brought mankind into a state of sin and misery.

Question 18: What is the sinfulness of that state into which man fell?
Answer: The sinfulness of the state into which man fell includes the guilt of Adam’s first sin,[a] the lack of the righteousness which he had at first, and the corruption of every part of his nature, which is commonly called Original Sin; together with all actual sins which flow from it.

Question 19: What misery did the fall bring upon mankind?
Answer: What misery did the fall bring upon mankind?

Question 20: Did God leave all mankind to perish in the state of sin and misery?
Answer: God, solely out of his love and mercy, from all eternity elected some to everlasting life, and entered into a covenant of grace to deliver them out of the state of sin and misery, and to bring them into a state of salvation by a Redeemer.

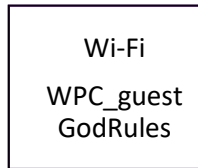
